Hospital Drone Contact Checklist

Hospital helipads are considered to be airports by the FAA.

This means that recreational drone users are required to notify a hospital if they are operating a drone within five miles of the facility. Should you receive a call please do the following:

Obtain from the drone operator:

- Contact Flight For Life by calling **414-778-3466** (non-emergent number)
Flight For Life will post the information to the hazard reporting site Weatherturndown.com
for all flight programs to access.

If a hospital department or subcontractor will be using a drone on or near the hospital campus:

- Contact Flight For Life at least 24 hours in advance at **414-778-3466** (non-emergent number) and then on the day of the drone operation prior to the drone being launched.

Provide the following information:

- Date _____
- Time-frame _____
- Altitude _____
- Location where the drone will be flying _____

- Provide the cell phone number of the staff member who will be escorting the drone operator

- FFL will contact him/her if there are incoming flights during that time and he/she will be asked to land the drone temporarily. FFL will post this information on Weatherturndown.com for all other flight programs to access.
